## Pick up Devices

Beginning Tuesday, March 17th from 10:00 am to 3:00 pm, students may come into the school and pick up their devices, books and any needed school materials. Students may also come in Wednesday, March 18th from 8:00 am to 3:00 pm to pick up needed items. If any students need to come at a later time, please call the school and schedule a time after hours.

Each family needs a reliable computer or laptop in order to complete school work. If one is not available for use, we will provide one Macbook per family, along with assigned iPads. If your household has a junior or senior who already has a Macbook, they will need to share with younger siblings. If you do not have internet access at home, please contact the school.

## Communication

Teachers will be available during regular school hours to answer emails and telephone calls. Daily assignments will be posted for your students. Please make sure students check his/her Canvas and school emails daily for instructions. Assignments will be given according to our regular A and B schedule.

## Special Education

Accommodations will be in place for all students with IEPs. Sally James and her staff will be contacting individual families with more information.

## Concurrent Enrollment Classes

We will be following all the guidelines that universities have put into place. Currently, Snow College is on break and will be conducting online classes beginning April 1st. SUU aviation class will be on Canvas until further notice.
